



First Language (L1)

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
Both L1 and L2


- Similar learning stages, particular structures being learnt in a relatively fixed order


Second Language (L2)

Tutor: a **big bedroom** okay .




Age (months)








xCRP: cross-speaker construction repetition proportion









Effect of Locality Cross-Speaker Construction Repetition

Conclusion

- Shared constructions form an important aspect of dialogue
- Construction use evolves as learner linguistic ability increases
- Learner dialogues show higher local construction repetition than in fluent adult dialogues, this decreases with learner ability
